#### Leaders Tasks

1. The Leader takes responsibility for the conduct of Sunday worship at St Peters, from preparation to unlocking and finally locking up at the end. This does not mean he has to do everything himself, but must ensure that everything is done! You can count on total backup and support from other leaders plus ushers and many others.
2. Liaise with Gunnar to prepare the service order well in advance. (By Wednesday at the latest so he has time to finish and print etc). Gunnar has a set of past service orders which can be used as a model.
3. Sermons can, as always be accessed on the LCA website, Gunnar will also give us a stick with pastor Paul's previous sermons for potential re-use here.
4. Ensure that someone is set to read the sermon and that the appropriate sermon has been sourced. Pastor Paul has also kindly left a set of past sermons which are a useful resource.
5. Ensure that songs have been chosen and musician(s) briefed. Lorraine is your contact person for this.
6. Leaders will gather after service on the last Sunday of the month for a leaders meeting over lunch.
7. Holy Communion to be conducted by one of the lay assistants, with three assisting the distribution.
